- Helmet** This is a mandatory item for ALL players. Lasts on the average 2-3 years.
- Skates** Plan for 1 season of use. These must fit well. Ask about our leasing program
- Stick** Plan on 2-3 per season depending on age.
- Shin Pads** Should last 1-2 seasons
- Elbow Pads** Should last 1-2 seasons
- Gloves** Usually lasts 1 season. (These guys grow fast)
- Shoulder Pads** Should last 1-2 seasons
- Mouthguard** Plan on 2 per year
- Hockey Pants/ Breezers** Should last 1-2 seasons. Do not purchase too large or it hinders skating ability
- Socks** 1-2 pair per season. Works best to have 1 pair for games & 1 for practice
- Tape** 3-6 rolls per season depending on extended uses. They make great pucks!
- Cup / Pelvic Protector with Supporter**  
Can last from 1-3 seasons
- Pucks**
- Bag** Depending on the bag you purchase it can last for 5+ yrs  
Size / Quality
- Laces** Always have a spare set in the hockey bag.
- Neck Protector** Average life of 3 years
- Garter Belt** Thing of the past. Purchase a supporter with velcro to hold up your socks
